Vintage Conditions

After some early rain events in the region, the vines thrived in what was a cooler summer with very few extreme heat days and no lengthy warm periods.

This led to even ripening amongst all varieties and saw both white and red varieties yield excellent quality grapes from Langhorne Creek.

The reds in general showed good colour and flavours with well-developed tannins without being jammy from over-ripeness.

100% Langhorne Creek, South Australia

Wine Making

The grapes were picked and crushed at optimal ripeness for the style that we wanted to achieve. They were then small batch processed with specific enzymes and yeasts to capture as much fruit and varietal character possible. After extended skin contact the must was then gently pressed before a short period in a mix of new and old French oak, not to impact too much on the natural fruit flavours prior to packaging.

WINEMAKER'S COMMENTS

Colour

This wine displays a deep plum colour.

Nose

The nose shows a blend of dark red fruits, crushed violets and mulberry.

Palate

The palate shows finesse in both fruit and structure, finishing long and dry.
